## CATCHING THE BUS

Buses will leave the stops shown in this booklet at the times mentioned. If waiting at a scheduled stop please be at least five minutes early.



Not all bus stops are shown on this timetable. Please wait at marked bus stops and hail the driver by raising your hand.



All Bayhopper Eastern Bay buses are fully accessible. Wheelchairs take priority in the dedicated wheelchair space.

## ON THE BUS - CODE OF CONDUCT

We want all of our buses to be friendly, safe, and inclusive for everyone. To achieve this, we ask you to take responsibility for your own behaviour.

### You have the right to:

- Be treated with respect
- Receive friendly and courteous service
- A safe, clean and comfortable travelling environment

### This means that you will not:

- Threaten, bully or harass other people on the bus
- Swear or use bad language
- Eat, drink, vape or smoke on the bus
- Tag, graffiti or damage the bus in any way
- Exhibit anti-social or disorderly behaviour

## You are responsible for:

- Respecting other peoples' rights
- Paying the correct fare
- Following any reasonable instructions from the driver and/or another company representative
- Good behaviour
- Telling us if you see anyone damaging the bus

Please follow this Code of Conduct so everyone can have a pleasant journey. If you don't comply with the Code of Conduct, it may result in removal of your right to use the bus and/or prosecution for unlawful behaviour.

## LEAVING THE BUS

Press the bell once as the bus approaches the stop where you want to get off. Make sure you press the bell with time for the driver to stop.

## PAYING FOR YOUR RIDE

The Bee Card is a prepaid card which makes travel by bus easier and smarter. Bee Cards cost \$5 and can be purchased online at [www.beecard.co.nz](http://www.beecard.co.nz), or from a Bay of Plenty Regional Council (BOPRC) office or a bus driver. Register your card at [www.beecard.co.nz](http://www.beecard.co.nz) to be eligible for concession fares. You can top your card up online or by cash with your bus driver.



## HOW DO TRANSFERS BETWEEN BUSES WORK?

When using a Bee Card, transfers between buses are automatically applied. Customers will need to tag on and tag off for each part of the journey; the system will not charge you any extra providing your journey is within the transfer rules.

### For Bee Cards

1. Free transfers between buses apply for two hours from your first tag on to your final tag off.
2. The transfer time between buses can be no more than 30 minutes.
3. You can have a maximum of two free transfers per journey.

## For cash fares:

1. Free transfers between buses apply for one hour from ticket purchase.
2. The transfer time between buses can be no more than 30 minutes.
3. You can have a maximum of one free transfer per journey.
4. You will need to present your ticket when transferring to the next bus.

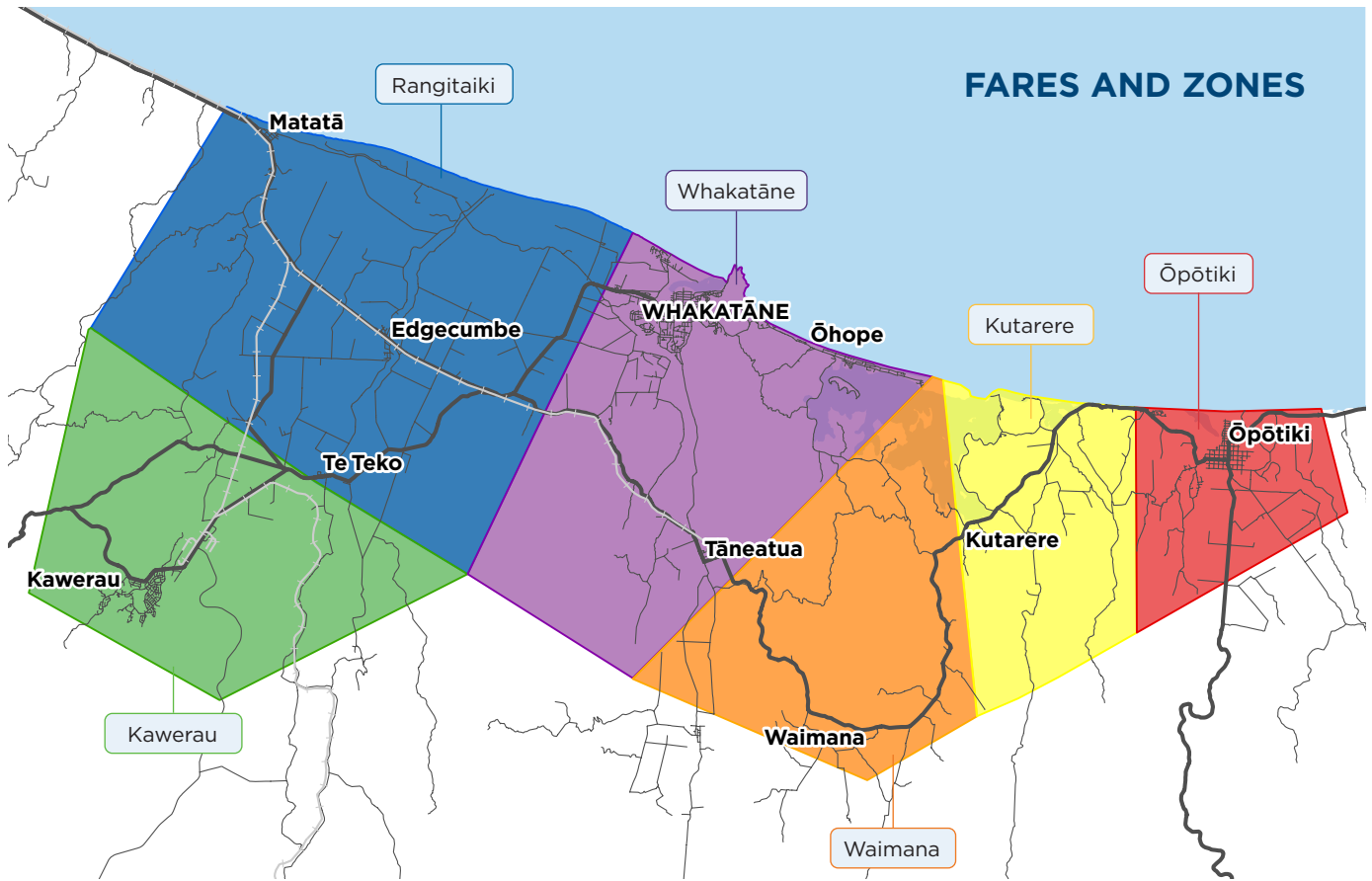

- Tertiary concessions can be loaded at a BOPRC office or via their tertiary institutes' student services.

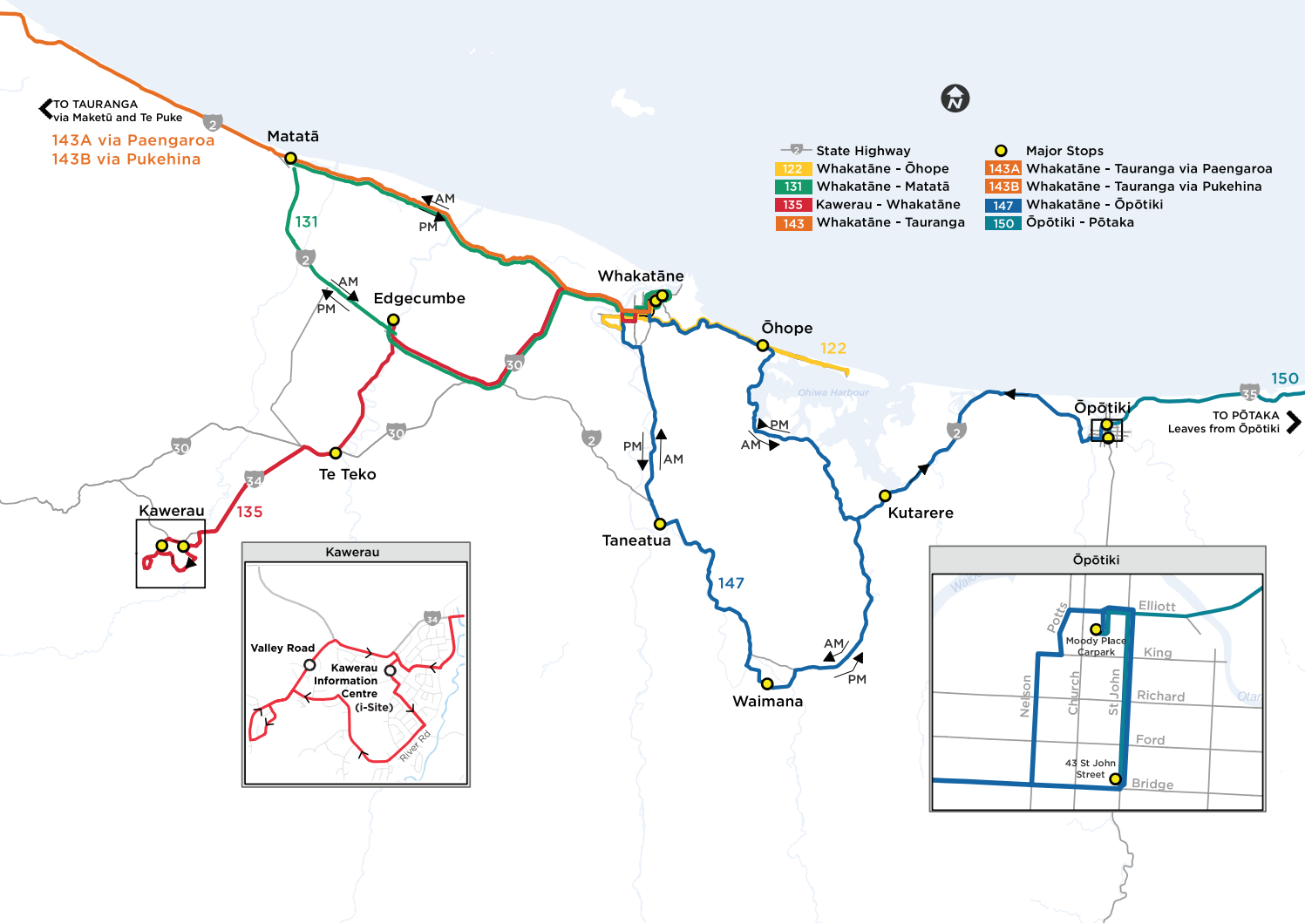

## Benefits of Bee Card

- Online access to your Bee Card for
  - online top up
  - automatic loading of concessions for for child, youth, youth plus, Community Connect and SuperGold
  - ability to view transaction and travel history
  - ability to cancel a lost or stolen card, and have the balance transferred to a new card. If a card is not registered, the balance cannot be transferred

- With the Bee Card you can have multiple Bee Cards attached to one account. This means the whole family, even extended family can be associated to the one account.

This is a great way for bus users who do not have Internet access to be able to obtain a Bee Card.

- Transfers are easier because you no longer need a paper ticket to transfer. Once you tag-off the first bus you have 30 minutes to tag on your next bus. Complete Transfer rules are on page 4.
